Adjudicators

Madeline Melrose

Madeline Melrose is a Doctoral graduate of the Elder Conservatorium of Music in Adelaide and was awarded the prestigious University Medal for her outstanding research. She completed her studies on full scholarship after being awarded the Australian Postgraduate Award. Her research areas of interest are closely related to her teaching and performance work and include topics that cover violin technique, music pedagogy, music performance, psychology, Australian music education, and chamber music.

Madeline's performance career began at the Adelaide Eisteddfod where she participated in various string sections as a child. As an adult, she has performed solo, orchestral, and chamber music works with various organisations including the Adelaide Symphony Orchestra, the Australian Chamber Orchestra, the Australian Youth Orchestra, and various chamber music festivals across Australia. She is a founding member of The Academy Piano Trio which launched in 2022.

As an educator, Madeline currently holds teaching positions at the Elder Conservatorium of Music, the University Senior College, and is a nationally accredited examiner for the Australian Music Examinations Board. She is passionate about teaching music in a way that creates excitement, inspiration, and enjoyment. She is enthusiastic about progress and musical direction, and inspiring new generations of musicians.

Steve King

Stephen King joined the Australian String Quartet as the viola player in 2012. Music has taken Stephen to diverse venues and festivals around Australia and the world. With the ASQ, Stephen has been integral in the development of projects with First Nations artists, new Australian commissions and recordings, and innovative cross-artform collaborations. Before joining the ASQ, Stephen was a member of the Australian Chamber Orchestra for nine years. As the ACO's education representative from 2004-2011, he played a major role in founding and building the Orchestra's education and emerging artists programs and ACO2.

Growing up in Canberra, Stephen learned the violin but fell for the darker tone of the viola after all but completing an architecture degree in Brisbane. Following the inspiring teaching of Elizabeth Morgan, he completed his studies in the USA with James Dunham (Cleveland Quartet), Kathy Murdock (Mendelssohn Quartet) and Michael Tree (Guarneri Quartet). From 1997 Stephen was violist of the Coolidge String Quartet based in Washington D.C. He holds a Doctorate in Chamber Music from the University of Maryland, having worked closely with the Emerson and Guarneri Quartets.

While living overseas, Stephen was also the Associate Principal Viola of the Boston Philharmonic Orchestra and a member of the Boston Modern Orchestra Project. He was on the faculty of the New England Conservatory Prep Division in Boston and the American String Teachers Association Workshops. In Australia he has been guest principal of the Adelaide, Melbourne and Tasmanian Symphony Orchestras. Stephen teaches viola and chamber music at the University of Adelaide, Elder Conservatorium and regularly tutors at National Music Camps for AYO.

Jennifer Newman

Adelaide born Jennifer Newman commenced violin studies at the age of nine. From 1972 to 1982 she continued her studies with the then concertmaster of the Adelaide Symphony Orchestra Mr Robert Cooper O.A.M. Jennifer toured with the Australian Youth Orchestra for the 1974 national tour, the 1975 South East Asian tour and the 1976 nine state tour of the United States of America.

In 1976 Jennifer commenced full time employment with the Adelaide Symphony Orchestra. Jennifer with her twin sister Julie have performed as soloists and have acted in principal positions with the orchestra over several years. Jennifer has also made several recordings for A.B.C. radio.

Jennifer was a founding member of the Adelaide Chamber Orchestra in 1978 and performed as the principal second violinist from 1983 to 1993. Jennifer also performed as a soloist with the Adelaide Chamber Orchestra on several occasions. Jennifer furthered her studies in London for a brief time with Emanuel Hurwitz. In 1980 she attended the Tanglewood Music Festival in Massachusetts on Fellowship. Jennifer then studied towards a Masters degree in performance and literature with Professor Zvi Zeitlin at the Eastman School of Music, New York on full scholarship.

Jennifer has been teaching violin since 1985 with students receiving numerous awards from both the Australian Music Examinations Board and in the Eisteddfod Special Performance Awards. Jennifer is an examiner in violin and viola, appointed by the Australian Music Examinations Board in 1996 and now assists with training sessions for new examiner. Jennifer performs on an Italian 1737 Camillus Camilli violin.

The Music Teachers Association of SA Inc. /Grace Barbara Turner Awards for Excellence in Performance

Four awards of \$100 will be made to competitors, one from each of the following Divisions: Keyboard, Strings, Wind and Vocal. Competitors must have performed as a soloist.

A plaque will be awarded to the most outstanding competitor for Violin, Viola, Cello or Double Bass 18 years or under.

The Jane Peters Violin Medallion

Awarded to the most promising violinist 16 years or under. Competitors must have performed as a soloist.

The David Bishop Cello Medallion

Awarded for the most promising cellist 16 years and under. Competitors must have performed as a soloist.

The Adele Anthony Violin Medallion

Awarded to the most outstanding violinist 13 years or under. Competitors must have performed as a soloist.

MBS Young Virtuoso Award SA

Competitors from the Adelaide Eisteddfod S939 String Player Recital may be selected to compete in the MBS Young Virtuoso Award, offered by the Australian Fine Music Network of community radio stations. The adjudicators will select the SA finalists through Recitals offered via the Piano, String, Flute and Woodwind Divisions and performances in the Vocal Division.
