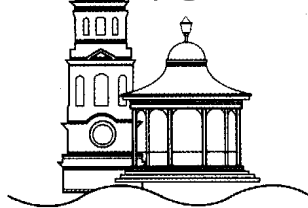

Thursday 26 July - Sunday 29 July 2017 Adjudicator: Jeffrey Kong

Jeffrey Kong commenced his piano studies at the age of 14 and he performed both the Beethoven C minor and Chopin F minor concertos at the age of 17. After gaining a scholarship to study at the Sydney Conservatorium of Music with Alexander Sverjensky, Lea De Metre and Gordon Watson. Alexander Sverjensky was reported to have studied with Rachmaninoff. After teaching at Newcastle Conservatorium and Canobolas High School in Orange, Jeffrey came to South Australia to teach at Brighton High School (now Brighton Secondary School). He also continued his studies with Clemens Leske and Lance Dossor at Adelaide University.

Graduate studies took Jeffrey to the US where he studied chamber music with Gwendolyn Koldofsky, pianist to Lotte Lehmann, at the University of Southern California in 1980. On his return to Australia he worked as repetiteur at the Sydney Conservatorium Opera School before returning to his position at Brighton Secondary School. In 1992, an Italian Government Scholarship took Jeffrey to Pesaro where he studied with Lorenzo Bavaï, pianist to Jose Carreras (one of the 'Three Tenors') at the Rossini Conservatorium in Pesaro, Italy.

In the past 40 years Jeffrey has been at the forefront of music education in South Australia. He was the Head of Music at Brighton Secondary School. Most recently he contributed to music education at Wilderness School, another outstanding Adelaide school.

He has performed at: Schoenberg Institute, University of Southern California, USA; Shanghai Conservatorium, Shanghai People Republic of China; St Peters Basilica, Vatican, Italy; St Marco Cathedral, Venezia, Italy; St Nicholas Church, Prague, Czech Republic; Bruges Concert Hall, Belgium.

Jeffrey recently retired from active school music education positions but maintains a strong interest in the musical development of young and aspiring musicians.

DEBRA ANDREACCHIO is a studio piano teacher and a PhD Candidate in Piano Pedagogy at The University of Adelaide. A music graduate, Debra extended her piano studies with Eleonora Sivan, and is grateful for her continuing professional contact.

Over the past decade, Debra has given many presentations at conferences focused on piano teaching and research. These have been delivered at Australasian Piano Pedagogy Conferences, and at Western Australian Piano Pedagogy Conventions. Internationally, she presented at the World Piano Teachers Conference in Novi Sad, Serbia (2012) and at the Research in Music Education Conference in the United Kingdom (2015). In addition, Debra has delivered scholarly papers at National Conferences of the Musicological Society of Australia.

Debra has contributed to the broader music community both in this state and nationally. Currently, she is a Deputy Chair of The Australasian Piano Pedagogy Conference Association (APPCA) and was Deputy Chair of the APPC 2017 conference, 'Keys to a Changing World'. Debra is a piano examiner for the Australian Music Examinations Board (AMEB) and has adjudicated music competitions including the Adelaide Eisteddfod and the Young Virtuoso Award SA Final. She was President of the Music Teachers Association of South Australia from 2009 to 2013, during which time she convened two major Summer Schools.

Over the years, Debra's students have engaged in many piano performance opportunities provided by Adelaide organizations, for example, with 'Tuesday on Flinders' at the Flinders St. Baptist Church, with Recitals Australia at Pilgrim Church, with the Public Schools Music Festival and the Metropolitan Male Choir as guest artists, and at AMEB Showcase Concerts.

Debra has taught in many Private Colleges and Public School Special Interest Music Centres, and is passionate about teaching and encouraging the next generation of musicians.

Any **withdrawals** are to be made via text to 0402 289 628 or email to jane@janeburgess.com.au Withdrawals are **NOT** to be made through the Adelaide Eisteddfod Office or the Booking-In area as they may not reach the Convenor in time. Rule 31 states that all withdrawals are to be made at least 24 hours in advance. Failure to do so will result in disqualification from the next scheduled section the competitor has entered. Emergency situations will be considered by the Convenor whose decision is final.

BOOKING IN

Booking In begins 30 minutes prior to the start of each section. Each competitor is required to advise the Piano Division of the Title of each piece being performed and the composer of each piece for every section they compete in. Competitors will be advised how this process will take place at a later date.

Music for the Adjudicator is to be clearly named and the page marked where there is a volume of work.

SPECIAL AWARDS

The Music Teachers' Association of South Australia Inc./Grace Barbara Turner Awards for Excellence in Performance

An award of \$100 will be made to a pianist who has demonstrated excellence in performance.

The Lady Anne Miller Award

Awarded to the competitor with the highest aggregate in the Piano Division. For this award, the following scoring system will be used: 1st Prize 5 points; 2nd Prize 3 points; 3rd Prize 2 points; Honourable Mention 1 point.

The Wilf Mader Memorial Medallion

Awarded to the most promising pianist 17 years and over.

The Miriam Hyde Medallion

Awarded to the most promising pianist 16 years and under.

Dulcie Holland Medallion

Awarded to the most promising pianist 12 years or under.

MBS Young Virtuoso Award SA

Entry in the SA Final of Young Virtuoso, offered by the Australian Fine Music Network of community radio stations, is through the Adelaide Eisteddfod. The adjudicators will select the SA finalists through Recitals offered via the Vocal, Piano, String, Flute, Woodwind, Recorder and Brass Divisions. The prizes for the SA Final will be: Vocal Prize: \$750; Instrumental Prize: \$750, SA Finalist Prize: \$1,500. These prizes are sponsored by Beta Sigma Phi, Size Music and 5mbs. Competitors from the Adelaide Eisteddfod P239 Senior Piano Recital aged 25 years or under on December 31, 2018, may be selected to compete in the MBS Young Virtuoso Award SA Final to be held on Sunday October 14th at 2.30pm at St John's Anglican Church, 379 Halifax Street. A winner from the SA Final will be selected to perform in the National Final in Brisbane on Sunday November 25 at the 4MBS Classic FM Performance Studio at Coorparoo. The winner of the National Final will receive the Young Virtuoso Scholarship of \$10,000 provided by Freemasons Victoria and the Australian Fine Music Network.
