Adjudicators

Elizabeth Koch AM, Alan Aungles & Joshua Oates

Elizabeth Koch AM is an Emeritas Fellow of the University of Adelaide. She was Associate Professor at the Elder Conservatorium of Music and Head of Woodwind for 21 years. Previously she was a member of the Adelaide Symphony Orchestra for 27 years. Elizabeth was also an Education Specialist with a keen interest in flute pedagogy and the training of young flautists to further their study both here and internationally. Several of Elizabeth's students have won positions in professional orchestras in Australia and many have been accepted at high level music institutions around the world.

Elizabeth was Principal Flute of the Australian Youth Orchestra and Adelaide Chamber Orchestra and has performed as soloist with the Adelaide Symphony Orchestra, Tasmanian Symphony Orchestra and Adelaide Chamber Orchestra. She was awarded a Churchill Fellowship to further her study in Paris and has played for Jean-Pierre Rampal, Maxence Larriieu, Andras Adorjan, Alain Marion, Sir James Galway, Susan Milan and William Bennett in international masterclasses.

In 2010 Elizabeth was awarded the Australian Learning and Teaching Prize for excellence in teaching at a national level and in 2016 was appointed as a Member of the Order of Australia (AM) in the Queen's Birthday Honours List for her significant service to music education.

Alan Aungles was a flute teacher with the Instrumental Music Service of South Australia from 1983-2023. A graudate of The Elder Conservatorium, Alan has played principal flute for SA State Opera, principal piccolo in the Adelaide Symphony Orchestra and been Lecturer in Music at Charles Darwin University. His invention, the Aungles Flute Microphone is sold in many locations around the world.

Joshua Oates has been Principal Oboe of the Adelaide Symphony Orchestra since 2020. Joshua has studied with some of today's leading oboists. He undertook a masters in Germany with Philippe Tondre, prior to which he was a fellow with the Sydney Symphony Orchestra under the mentorship of Diana Doherty. During his time in Germany, Joshua played in many theatre orchestras, as well as guest principal with Cappella Aquileia Heidenheim. He has also played as guest principal in most of Australia's professional orchestras.

Joshua's undergraduate studies took place at the Elder Conservatorium of Music Adelaide with Celia Craig, where he graduated with first class honours. In 2021 he returned to the Elder Conservatorium as Oboe teacher, and is passionate about working with the next generation of Australia's Oboists. He is also a keen recital and chamber musician, and had his premiere as solo artist at the Australian Festival of Chamber Music in 2023. In 2025 Joshua will appear as concerto soloist with the Bendigo Symphony Orchestra and Adelaide Symphony Orchestra.

Any withdrawals are to be made via email to flute@adelaideeisteddfod.com.au Withdrawals are NOT to be made through the Adelaide Eisteddfod Office or the Booking-In area as they may not reach the Convenor in time. Rule 32 states that: Competitors unable to perform in a section they have entered MUST NOTIFY the Convenor at least 24 hours beforehand. Failure to do so may result in disqualification from their next scheduled section. Emergency situations will be considered by the Convenor whose decision will be final.

BOOKING IN

On the day of the competition, competitors are required to **Book In 30 minutes** prior to the section start time. Music that has not been submitted through Stardom for the adjudicator must be handed in during this time.
